# AN EMPLOYER'S GUIDE TO HIRING EMPLOYEES\*

- 1. Apply online for your Federal ID# at <a href="https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/fss4.pdf">www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/fss4.pdf</a>.
- 2. Apply online for your Minnesota State ID# at <a href="mailto:taxes.state.mn.us/business\_taxpayers/pages/business\_registration\_index.aspx">taxpayers/pages/business\_registration\_index.aspx</a>.
- 3. Determine what position(s) you are hiring for and develop a list of job duties and requirements.
- 4. Read Publication 15, Employer's Tax Guide at <a href="https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/p15.pdf">www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/p15.pdf</a>.
- 5. Read the Minnesota Income Tax Withholding information at <a href="mailto:taxes.state.mn.us/Forms\_and\_">taxes.state.mn.us/Forms\_and\_</a> Instructions/wh inst 12.pdf.
- 6. Go to <a href="www.deed.state.mn.us/publications/index.htm">www.deed.state.mn.us/publications/index.htm</a> and either order or download a copy of "An Employer's Guide to Employment Law Issues in Minnesota."
- 7. Determine your responsibility for paying Unemployment Insurance at www.uimn.org.
- 8. Determine with your insurance agent the appropriate Worker's Compensation Insurance necessary.
- Study the Department of Labor website at <u>www.doli.state.mn.us</u> to ensure you understand your responsibilities related to labor standards, workers compensation, safety, and other employment issues.
- 10. Develop your payroll process. Who will conduct your payroll? What system will be used? Contact a payroll service provider (e.g., CPA, bank, ADP) and/or evaluate do-it-yourself systems like QuickBooks.

# Remember, it is imperative you are familiar with the requirements for:

- Withholding Taxes
- Federal Tax Withholding
- Social Security taxes
- Medicare taxes
- State Tax Withholding
- Unemployment Insurance
- Workers Compensation Insurance
- Labor Standards

Severe and strict penalties apply to not fulfilling all employer requirements. Familiarity and adherence to these requirements is crucial to the success of your business.
